Water supply bylaw

We've updated our rules for our areas around our raw water source, which is where we get our water from before we treat it to make it safe to drink. We've also clarified that some areas of our water supply network have restricted flow, and that we're not obliged to provide new connections for purposes other than domestic purposes e.g. for industry and agriculture. We're also proposing to remove the water supply bylaw that applies only to the Kaiaua, Pūkorokoro / Miranda areas that were part of the Franklin District in the past. Drainage Bylaw

We've renamed our bylaw to reflect that it's also about stormwater drainage in our townships. We've made some changes to the rules around how close to our drains you can plant vegetation, such as crops. We're also removing the allowance for stock to use drains for drinking water, as we want to reduce the likelihood of effluent entering our waterways. We've also clarified that you need our permission to have a crossing that crosses a drain, and it's your responsibility to ensure any crossing is safe and clear from debris. Solid Waste Bylaw

We've clarified the current rule that says you can only put waste items in the specified containers and that you can't overload your collection bins. We've also clarified that no one should cause a nuisance by gathering or storing most waste. We've removed some requirements around operators to be licensed by the Council because this was not implemented in the past, and we've also removed rules about damage to our transfer stations. We're proposing to remove the Waste Bylaw that applies only to the Kaiaua, Pūkorokoro / Miranda areas that were part of the Franklin District in the past.
